

DIRECTIONS TO LA GRAND' FERME

La Grand' Ferme
16, Le Fougeray,
50530 Bacilly,
Normandie

From Caen take the A84 direction Rennes/Mont St Michel. Follow the dual carriageway to Avranches but do not head towards the town centre – stick on the dual carriageway towards Mont St Michel. As you are by-passing Avranches (you'll see a large church on top of the hill on your left) turn off the dual carriageway at exit D973 towards Granville, Jullouville (also marked Gare SNCF).

At roundabout take first exit to Granville and the road bends to the right over a bridge at Marcey-les-Greves. At the next roundabout, immediately after bridge, turn left towards Jullouville/Vains (D911). This crossroads is at a junction with a pharmacy and a couple of bars. You may notice a big Peugeot garage on the road that you want to take. Stay on the Jullouville/Vains/Genets road until you come to the village of Le Fougeray – village sign in black/white on right hand side is easy to miss! Just past the sign, you'll come to a crossroads with BSA Construction/MSP ahead of you – turn left to Le Grand Port (D41) at these crossroads (opposite the turning to Bacilly). La Grand'Ferme is at about 400m on your right – a long building with white arch windows (see photo below)

From Le Havre - from the port of Le Havre follow the signs "Toutes directions" and then those to Pont de Normandie and Caen. There are a couple of road tolls which accept cash or a credit card. From Caen take the A84 direction Rennes/Mont St Michel. (*Follow same directions from Caen*).

From St Malo follow green signs to Mont St Michel/Caen. Keep following signs to Caen which will take you onto the A83/84 dual carriageway.

As you by-pass Avranches take the exit D973 to Granville (also marked Gare SNCF) – this exit is just opposite MacDonaldis before a bridge. Follow road up and round to the roundabout. Take first exit to Granville at the roundabout and the road bends to the right over a bridge at Marcey-les-Greves. At the crossroads immediately after bridge turn left towards Jullouville/Vains (D911). This crossroads is at a junction with a pharmacy and a couple of bars. You may notice a big Peugeot garage on the road that you want to take. Stay on the Jullouville/Vains/Genets road until you come to the village of Le Fougeray – village sign in black/white on right hand side is easy to miss! Just past the sign, you'll come to a crossroads with BSA Construction/MSP ahead of you – turn left to Le Grand Port (D41) at these crossroads (opposite the turning to Bacilly). La Grand' Ferme is at about 400m on your right – a long building with white arch windows (see photo below)

From Cherbourg follow green signs to Rennes/Mont St Michel/Caen on to the N13-E3 dual carriageway. After about 12 miles, just look out for signs to Mont St Michel. Just after the turning to Valognes, turn off the E3 onto the D2 direction Mont St Michel. Stay on this road to Coutances and then on towards Granville – now on the D971. As you by-pass Granville turn off to Avranches, onto the D973 Direction Avranches & Mont St Michel.

After the village of Sartilly you will climb a hill up to a crossroads (La Butte es Gros) – there is a large builder's yard called Guilloux on the junction on the brow of the hill. Turn right at this junction towards Bacilly onto the D41. Drive through Bacilly and on towards Le Fougeray – the turning is just past the village church but bear left then right towards Le Fougeray. At the next junction (MSP or BSA Construction on right) go straight over towards Le Grand Port on the D41. La Grand' Ferme is about 400m on your right – a long building with white arch windows (see photo below)
